The Audiology Department at Fairford Hospital

We have a referral from your General Practitioner asking us to assess your hearing.

Your appointment with us is a chance for you to talk to us about your hearing and to see if we can help you hear better.

Before Your Appointment:

- Have your ears checked for wax at your General Practitioner surgery at least 10-14 days prior to attending this appointment to allow for a course of treatment to be completed if required, otherwise any treatment may be delayed.
- Make sure you have not been exposed to loud sounds 24 hours before your appointment.
- If you require an interpreter please contact us in advance if you wish us to arrange this for you.
- If you have any questions regarding this appointment please contact the Audiology Department directly.

Things to Bring With You:

- Any hearing aids that you may already have.

- A list of your current medication.
- Please feel free to bring a relative or friend who knows you well.

Your Appointment:

- Your appointment will last for approximately one hour.
- We will start by asking you a few questions about your ears and your concerns surrounding your hearing.
- We will then do a full examination of your ears and check for any abnormalities.
- We will test your hearing – this takes approximately 10-20 minutes.
- We will explain the results straight away and talk you through the impact that a hearing loss can have on your communication skills.
- Dependent on the results of the testing we may discuss hearing aids with you.
- We may also recommend an onward referral to another specialty (Ear, Nose and Throat Department) if needed.
