The Audiology Department: Future appointments at Fairford Hospital

Once a patient in our care any future appointments that you make with Audiology can allow us to discuss your hearing needs and ensure that your hearing aids are fully functioning.

Appointments:

- Once you have been issued with hearing aids you can contact us to arrange further appointments. Our contact details are on the reverse of this sheet.
- When you book an appointment it is helpful if you tell us exactly what problems you are experiencing.
- We recommend that you arrange a 'hearing aid service' appointment every six to nine months.
- We recommend that you have your hearing retested every three to five years unless you notice a problem sooner.
- We offer appointments at the main hospital site in Swindon but also at Savernake & Fairford hospitals and Malmesbury Primary Care Centre.

- Your Audiologist can refer you, if required, for further appointments with staff who specialise in tinnitus and balance rehabilitation.
- If you require an interpreter please contact us in advance if you wish us to arrange this for you.

Things to Bring With You:

- Any NHS hearing aids that you already have.
- Your record card and any used batteries.
- Please feel free to bring a relative or friend who knows you well.

Things to Remember:

- Your hearing aids have been set for your hearing levels – please do not let other people use them.
- Please keep your hearing aids safe. If you misplace or severely damage a hearing aid there will be an administration fee of £135 per hearing aid to replace it.
- If you notice a sudden dramatic loss of hearing please contact your local Emergency Department.
