



Eye Clinic: What to do on the day of your local anaesthetic cataract surgery

- Eat and drink as normal before you come to hospital.
- Take your medication/eye drops as normal, including blood thinning tablets and insulin.
- Wear comfortable clothes with a short or loose sleeve top to allow access for blood pressure check.
- Book into Day Services on the 1st Floor at GWH (opposite the Eye Clinic).
- Expect to be in Day Services for anything up to six hours.
- Please bring a phone number of your relative/friend, who is going to pick you up after the surgery.
