IMPORTANT INFORMATION (Nursing staff to delete as appropriate)

You have had some clips placed in your These will fall out on their own within....., and pass in your stool. You may not be aware of this happening. However if you are requested to have a MRI scan you must let the radiographers know that you have had these clips in place as it is possible this type of scan cannot be performed whilst they are still in place.

You have had a metal stent (tube) placed in your bile duct during your Endoscopic Retrogradecholepanthography (ERCP) on This means that if you are recommended to have a Magnetic Resonance Scan whilst it is place, you must inform the radiography department that you have a metal stent in-place prior to attending for your appointment.

This will need to be removed in approximately.....days/weeks' time.
